PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

AcctoFi — Powered TXCPA: AcctoFi is a separate 501(c)(3) organization focused on expanding access to high-quality accounting education and supporting the next generation of CPAs. AcctoFi delivers hundreds of continuing education programs annually in a variety of formats designed to keep accounting and finance professionals current, prepared, and fully compliant with Texas' ongoing CPE requirements.

Peer Review Program: Since 1989, TXCPA has administered the peer review program for Texas CPA firms engaged in accounting and auditing. This mandatory practice-monitoring system helps ensure the quality and integrity of services provided to the public. Firms must undergo a peer review every three years to meet Texas State Board of Public Accountancy requirements.

Governmental Affairs and Advocacy: TXCPA is the voice of Texas CPAs at the State Capitol and across all levels of government. We work to promote legislation that strengthens the CPA profession, supports a reliable business climate, and protects the public interest. TXCPA provides lawmakers and regulators with expert insight to help them understand the essential role CPAs play in the state's economic health and financial transparency.

TXCPA PAC: The TXCPA Political Action Committee monitors issues important to CPAs and helps ensure that the profession's perspectives are represented in public policy discussions.
