

TXCPA offers a variety of membership categories and dues classes. The following table details the requirements and dues for each group.

<b>Membership Category</b>	<b>Dues</b>	<b>Definition / Requirements</b>
CPA	\$295 plus required chapter dues	CPAs holding valid and unrevoked certificates issued by the State Board of Public Accountancy of any state or territory of the United States or District of Columbia, whether or not engaged in the public practice of accountancy, and not meeting the requirements of a retired, lifetime, 40-year member, or honorary member.
CPA – Retired w/SB CPA – Retired CPA – Unemployed 40 Year Member	\$125 (includes chapter dues - \$90 TXCPA/\$35 chapter)	CPA members who hold a retired license status with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy and inactive CPAs (not working), <b>AND</b> CPA members who have obtained 40 consecutive years of membership in TXCPA subsequent to May 31, 2015.
Lifetime Honorary CPA Honorary Member	\$0	A CPA who has obtained 40 consecutive years of membership in TXCPA prior to June 1, 2015, <b>AND</b> those individuals who have performed outstanding service to TXCPA or the profession, and upon whom this honor has been bestowed by the TXCPA Board of Directors.
CPA – New Licensee	\$0	New Texas CPAs are automatically activated as members the month after they receive their license from the State Board. Free membership is for the fiscal year in which they are licensed. February, March, April and May licensees receive free membership for the following fiscal year.
Student Member	\$0	College students majoring in a business-related field of study.
Candidate Member	\$125 (includes chapter dues - \$90 TXCPA/\$35 chapter)	Non-CPA members within five years of graduation or within five years of passing the CPA exam but not yet certified.

<b>Membership Category</b>	<b>Dues</b>	<b>Definition / Requirements</b>
Academic Affiliate	\$125 (includes chapter dues - \$90 TXCPA/\$35 chapter)	Non-CPA high school or college/university educators who teach business-related classes.
Non-CPA Employee Affiliates	\$125 (includes chapter dues - \$90 TXCPA/\$35 chapter)	Non-CPA employees who work for/are supervised by a current TXCPA CPA member on a substantially full-time basis and are sponsored by that member.
International Affiliate	\$295 plus required chapter dues	Accounting professionals holding a valid and unrevoked certificate or license issued by a foreign credentialing entity recognized by TXCPA.

### **Dues Information**

All dues are payable on June 1 of each year. The membership year begins on June 1 and ends on May 31 of the following year.

### **Reinstatement Procedures**

A former member who forfeited membership as provided in Article III (2) for nonpayment of dues or assessments may be reinstated by taking the action described below:

(1) The former member shall be reinstated by payment prior to May 31 following the date of forfeiture of dues, special assessment, if any, and appropriate chapter dues for the entire year. (2) Subsequent to May 31 following the date of forfeiture, the former member will be reinstated by completing an application for membership in the same manner as a new member and making payment of: (a) TSCPA and chapter dues for a proportionate quarterly part of the current fiscal year, and (b) may any outstanding assessments owing for the year in which membership was forfeited.

Former member reinstating their membership during the last quarter of the fiscal year are required to pay prorated dues for the last quarter and dues for the next fiscal year.

### **Pro Rata Payment of Dues**

If application for reinstatement is submitted -

- First Quarter: (June, July or August)...100% dues payable and appropriate chapter dues
- Second Quarter: (September, October or November)...75% dues payable and appropriate chapter dues
- Third Quarter: (December, January or February)...50% dues payable and appropriate chapter dues
- Fourth Quarter: (March, April or May)...25% dues payable and appropriate chapter dues
  - Members joining in the fourth quarter will also be billed for the following year
