



MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES	DUES
CPAs: CPAs holding valid and unrevoked certificates issued by the State Board of Public Accountancy of any state or territory of the United States or District of Columbia, whether or not engaged in the public practice of accountancy, and not meeting the requirements of a retired, lifetime, 40-year member, or honorary member. Also open to accounting professionals holding a valid and unrevoked certificate or license issued by a foreign credentialing entity recognized by TXCPA.	\$295, plus chapter dues (ranges from \$20 - \$150)
RETIRED CPAs, LEGACY MEMBERS or UNEMPLOYED CPAs: CPA members who are retired or hold a retired license status with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy, CPA members who have obtained 40 consecutive years of membership in TXCPA subsequent to May 31, 2015, or CPA members who are not gainfully employed.	\$125, including \$35 in chapter dues
LIFETIME or HONORARY: A CPA who has obtained 40 consecutive years of membership in TXCPA prior to June 1, 2015, or an individual who has performed outstanding service to TXCPA or the profession, and upon whom this honor has been bestowed by the TXCPA Board of Directors.	FREE
FACULTY AMBASSADORS: CPA or non-CPA full-time college or university accounting educator who has completed the application process with TXCPA for the academic year. Only one faculty ambassador will be approved for each campus.	FREE
BUSINESS AND ACCOUNTING EDUCATORS: High school or college/university educators who teach business-related classes on a part-time or full-time basis. CPAs and non-CPAs are eligible for this member category.	\$125, including \$35 in chapter dues
ACCOUNTING AND FINANCE PROFESSIONALS: Open to industry-related credential holders, non-CPA professionals working with and sponsored by a TXCPA CPA member, and non-CPA professionals holding a bachelor’s degree who work in the accounting/finance function in an organization.	\$295, including \$85 in chapter dues
CANDIDATES: Non-CPA members who have graduated within the past five years and are pursuing a CPA license or those who are within five years of passing the CPA exam but not yet certified.	\$125, including \$35 in chapter dues
STUDENTS—FREE: College students enrolled in a business-related field of study, excluding those who have earned a CPA or related credential.	FREE
ASSOCIATES: Not a licensed CPA, does not qualify for any other membership categories. Offers a related service or product for accounting and finance professionals. Requires two TXCPA CPA member sponsors.	\$595, including \$165 in chapter dues

Pro-rate Schedule

- Q1 (June, July & Aug) pays 100 % of dues
- Q2 (Sept, Oct & Nov) pays 75% of dues
- Q3 (Dec, Jan & Feb) pays 50% of dues



- **Q4 (Mar thru April 14) pays 25%.**
- **Any new member that joins after April 14 will pay 100% of dues, and revenue will be reflected in the 2023-2024 budget year.**
