

Threshold for Tax Year 2023

The low-to-moderate income threshold for FY 2024, Tax Year 2023, is \$64,000.

The threshold is based on tax year 2023 EITC AGI limits as shown below:

Earned income and adjusted gross income (AGI) must each be less than:

- \$56,838 (\$63,398 if Married Filing Jointly) with three or more qualifying children
- \$52,918 (\$59,478 if Married Filing Jointly) with two qualifying children
- \$46,560 (\$53,120 if Married Filing Jointly) with one qualifying child
- \$17,640 (\$24,210 if Married Filing Jointly) with no qualifying child

The maximum EITC for 2023:

- \$7,430 with three or more qualifying children
- \$6,604 with two qualifying children
- \$3,995 with one qualifying child
- \$600 with no qualifying child

Investment income limit: \$11,000
