



2024 ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA AND INSTRUCTIONS

TXCPA Houston Foundation (TXCPA Houston) offers a scholarship program whose purpose is to provide financial assistance to accounting students who plan to become Certified Public Accountants and enter the accounting profession in Texas.

Criteria:

To be considered for a TXCPA Houston scholarship, a student must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal Texas resident (green card holder).
- Be an accounting major preferably entering their senior year at an accredited four-year college or university, or a graduate student pursuing a masters degree in accounting in an accredited program, or those seeking the additional 30 hours of education to become eligible for a CPA license in Texas.
- Student should be following a plan to complete a minimum of 90 credit hours by August 2024.
- College or university should be located within the Houston CPA Society's thirteen-county membership area.
- File an Application of Intent with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA). This does not apply to Rice University MACC students.
- Have a GPA of at least 3.25 in accounting and 3.0 overall.
- Have taken a minimum of 12 hours in accounting courses This does not apply to Rice University MACC students.
- Have declared accounting as the major.
- Have been considered a full-time student (at least 12 hours per semester if an undergraduate and 9 hours per semester if a graduate student) immediately prior to the current semester.
- Be a member of TXCPA Houston. Complimentary TXCPA student membership is available.
- Demonstrate financial need, superior ethics, social responsibility, and high scholastic achievement on campus based on the judgment of accounting faculty.
- o Be planning to continue in an educational program at the university through the Fall semester of 2024.

Instructions:

- 1. Official transcripts from colleges or universities, where the applicant is currently and was previously enrolled, must be submitted with this application; original transcripts should be mailed, or secure link emailed.
- 2. A recommendation letter from the professor or person in charge of the accounting or business program at the institution where applicant is presently enrolled must accompany this application, as well as signing the application form. The letter from the professor may be sent separately via email.
- 3. Send this application, the official transcript, verification that the application of intent has been mailed to the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA), and the letter of recommendation to the TXCPA Houston. (see last page for the address.)
- 4. DUE DATE: All items the completed application form, TSBPA receipt of Application of Intent, transcripts from colleges and universities attended and presently attending, and a letter of recommendation must be received by TXCPA Houston no later than **April 30, 2024..**
- 5. TXCPA Houston and the Accounting Scholarship Committee reserve the right to refrain from awarding scholarships in the event applicants do not meet the desired qualifications.
- 6. Students receiving scholarship awards are expected to participate in TXCPA Houston activities when possible.
