



2026 ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

CRITERIA AND INSTRUCTIONS

TXCPA Houston Foundation (TXCPA Houston) offers a scholarship program whose purpose is to provide financial assistance to accounting students who plan to become Certified Public Accountants and enter the accounting profession in Texas. Eligible applicants approved for funding will receive \$500 towards tuition and fees at the community college system attending.

Criteria:

To be considered for a TXCPA Houston scholarship, **a student must:**

- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal Texas resident (green card holder).
- Be an accounting major entering their senior year at an accredited four-year college or university, or a student seeking the additional 30 hours of education to become eligible for a CPA license in Texas.
- File an Application of Intent with the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA).
- Have a GPA of at least 3.25 in accounting and 3.0 overall.
- Have completed a minimum of 12 hours in accounting courses
- Have declared accounting as the major.
- Currently be taking a course load which will satisfy eligibility requirements to take the CPA exam – such student may already have a Bachelor's degree in an area other than Accounting and is taking additional courses in accounting to meet the qualifications to take the CPA exam.
- Be a member of TXCPA Houston. Complimentary student membership is available at www.tx.cpa
- Demonstrate financial need, superior ethics, social responsibility, and high scholastic achievement on campus based on the judgment of accounting faculty.
- Be planning to continue in an educational program at the university through the Fall semester of 2026.

Instructions:

1. Official transcripts from colleges or universities, where the applicant is currently and was previously enrolled, must be submitted with this application; original transcripts should be mailed, or secure link emailed.
2. A recommendation letter from the professor or person in charge of the accounting or business program at the institution where applicant is presently enrolled must accompany this application, as well as signing the application form. The letter from the professor may be sent separately via email.
3. Send this application, the official transcript, verification that the application of intent has been received by Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA), and the letter of recommendation to the TXCPA Houston. (see last page for the address.)
4. **DUE DATE:** All items – the completed application form, TSBPA receipt of Application of Intent, transcripts from colleges and universities attended and presently attending, and a letter of recommendation must be received by TXCPA Houston no later than **April 15, 2026**.
5. TXCPA Houston and the Accounting Scholarship Committee reserve the right to refrain from awarding scholarships in the event applicants do not meet the desired qualifications.
6. Students receiving scholarship awards are expected to participate in TXCPA Houston activities when possible.
