The current program represents approximately 20 hours of CPE if you attend all sessions, including Early Bird and Sips and CPE. TSBPA rules state: the total CPE credits for a continuous program cannot exceed the actual time spent in the program. Continuous conferences and conventions, when individual segments are less than 50 minutes, should be combined and counted as one total program. For example, five 30-minute presentations would equal 150 minutes and should be counted as three CPE credits.

For every 50 minutes, you will receive 1 credit hour of CPE. For every 30 minutes, you will receive a half hour of credit.

CPAs are responsible for reporting the correct amount of hours.
