The Scholarships

The generosity of the TXCPA Rio Grande Valley allows the Foundation to fund scholarships to Rio Grande Valley college students. The recipients of these scholarships are accounting majors at the University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) that have the intent of becoming a Texas Certified Public Accountant and entering the profession upon graduation. They must have a high cumulative GPA and perform well in accounting classes. The scholarships range between \$500-\$1000 for the academic year.

To be considered for the TXCPA Rio Grande Valley scholarship, a student must be currently enrolled as a student at UTRGV and meet the criteria below:

- Be an accounting major or graduate student and have completed at least 12 hours of accounting courses before the Fall of the year of application. Principles of Accounting I and II do not count towards the 12 hours.
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 and Accounting GPA of 3.5 or more on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must complete the TSBPA's Application of Intent and submit with this scholarship application a copy of the TSBPA's acknowledgement of receipt of the application of intent.
